PRINCIPLES OF UNIVERSAL DESIGN

Useful for All: Useable by everyone in the anticipated audience.

Flexibility in Use: Adaptable to users' needs.

Simple and Intuitive Use: Easy to understand and use.

Perceptible Information: Clear and effective communication.

Tolerance for Error: Minimizes mistakes (example: warnings).

Ease of Use Effort: Requires minimal physical effort.

Size and Space Use: (accommodate body space)

Navigation Ease & Speed

• locate sections by tab, mouse, keyboard, or voice

Enhances Readability

- breaks up text blocks
- consistency

Formatting is Easy

- Design Tab in Word changes formats
- PDF Export with structure
- Auto generate Table of Contents

Collaboration

• Helps segment sections when working together




Creating a Business Report

When writing a business report, you want it to be easy to read. Dense bloc so break up your report with lists, headings/subheadings, and white space font, such as Calibri (Word's default font), Arial, or Times New Roman. He communication you may want to keep in mind when writing a report:

- Plan before you write.
- Know your audience.
- Use active voice.
- Avoid wordiness.
- Use plain language; avoid overblown words.
- Don't use clichés.
- Use parallel structure.
- · Edit out anything that doesn't add to your meaning
- · Organize your writing into short sections.

Setting Margins

Margins determine the amount of white space around the edges of the the entire document, a section, or selected text. The default margins in Spaced (Blank) templates, as well as many others, are one inch all arou of preset margins, or you can set your own custom margins.
