The Edge browser has tools to help improve focus.

- Have web and pdf text read aloud
- Have text translated
- Have text defined
- Adjust text size, text spacing, and the page background
- Annotate PDF
- Right click on any text and open immersive reader

Quick Tips for Students using Word

This uses the Learning Tools Tab (Office 365)

Go to **View > Learning Tools**, and select your options:

- **Column Width** changes line length to improve focus and comprehension.
- **Page Color** can make text easy to scan with less eye strain.
- **Text Spacing** increases the spacing between words, characters, and lines.
- **Syllables** shows breaks between syllables
- **Read Aloud** lets you hear your document as each word is highlighted.

Go to **Home> Dictate**, and turn on the microphone to have your voice automatically transcribed on the page as words.

Go to **Home>Editor** for help with writing conventions and suggestions.

Keyboard shortcuts for Read Aloud

In the desktop version of Word:

- Start or exit Read Aloud: Ctrl+Alt+Space
- Pause or play Read Aloud: Ctrl+Space
- Go to Review – Read Aloud
